JEFF COOPER

Jeff Cooper is, without a doubt, the most widely respected and the most knowledgeable man alive today in combat pistolcraft. He is the founder, first President, and Honorary Lifetime Chairman of the International Practical Shooting Confederation (IPSC). He is the founder, first director, and Combat Master of the Southwest Pistol League. He is also Assistant Professor of Police Science at Northern Arizona University. He holds a Master's Degree in History and a Bachelor's Degree in Political Science. He is the director and founder of the American Pistol Institute, and the President of the Gunsite Raven Corporation.

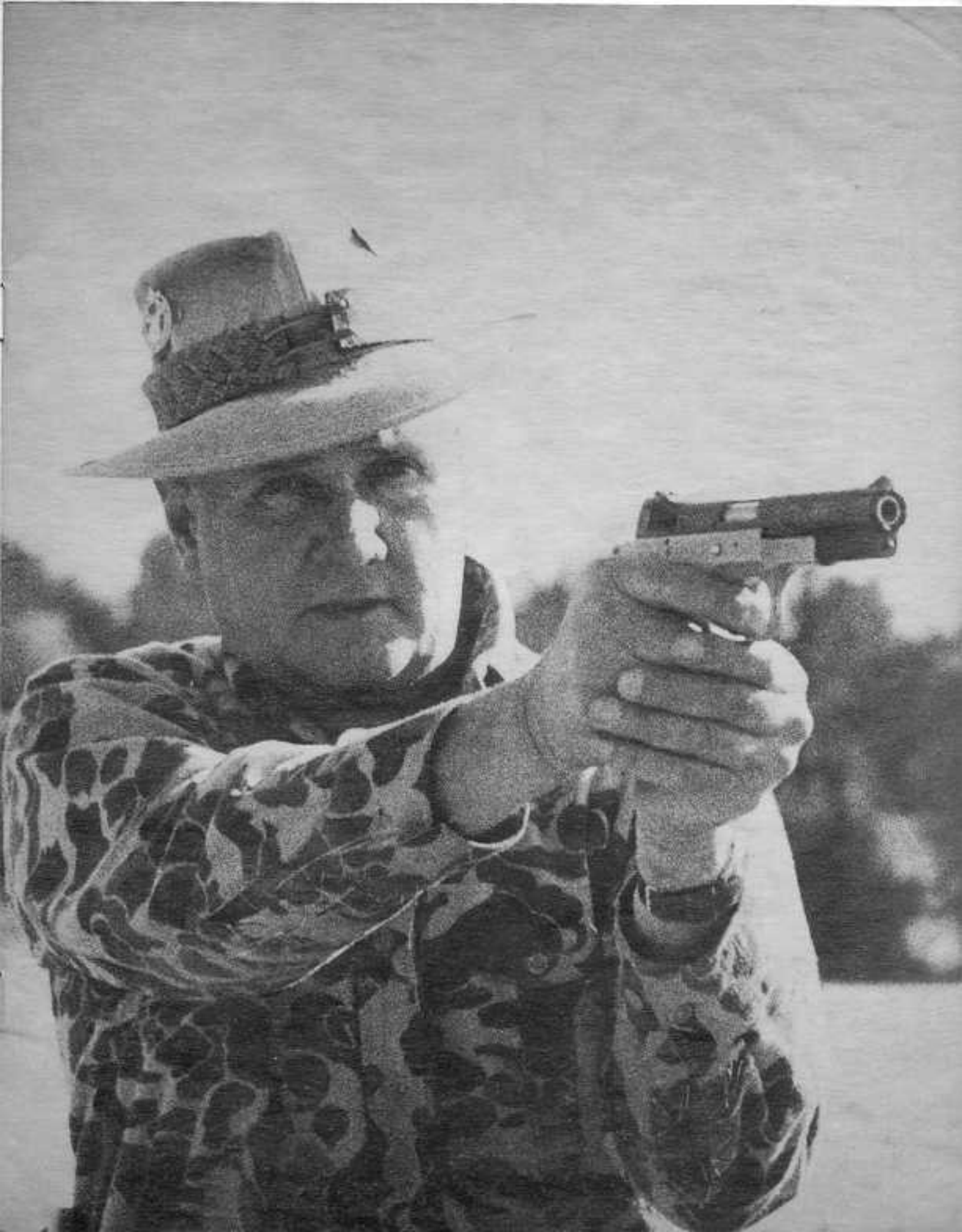
Jeff Cooper is internationally known as the father of the modern technique of combat pistolcraft. His system for teaching the practical discipline of modern handgunning is so successful, that today's champions are all either associates of his, students of his, or students of his students.

He has written several books on firearms. In addi-

tion, he has written hundreds of magazine articles for various magazines. He is a former Lieutenant Colonel in the United States Marine Corps. Most recently, Jeff has been elected to the Board of Directors of the National Rifle Association. And, he is the conceptual designer and technical advisor on the Bren Ten Program.

Jeff has stated that after he has fully tested and approved of the production Bren Ten, he will hang-up and retire his Colt .45 Auto and personally carry and teach with the Bren Ten. His testing is rigorous, with his criteria being 999 full-cycle feedings and firings out of 1000 attempts — a standard few of today's production pistols can achieve straight out of the box. His testing also includes practical combat conditions reliability, drop tests, mud and sand function tests, and combat accuracy tests.

The production Bren Ten has earned its reputation as the "finest handgun ever made," as well as Jeff Cooper's stamp of approval, which he does not give lightly.



BREN TEN

The Bren Ten is a heavy-duty combat service pistol designed to fire the 10mm Auto pistol cartridge. Both the Bren Ten and the 10mm cartridge have been designed and developed from the ground up. The Bren Ten represents a breakthrough in production pistols. It has all of the custom features of the most refined combat pistols available, without these features costing extra. It is truly ready-to-go, right out-of-the-box.

FULL-SIZE MODEL FEATURES INCLUDE:

Selective double/single action — can be carried cocked and locked (condition one), or hammer down and used double action by just pulling the trigger. Each successive shot after the first double action shot, will be single action.

Positive Cross-Bolt firing pin block.

Fully adjustable rear sight — adjustable for windage and elevation, yet is rigidly locked into place and is fully protected against accidental blows.

Exclusive "Power-Seal" rifling — allows the bullet to completely seal in the barrel, effectively eliminating gas leakage, thus increasing efficiency and velocity.

Reversible thumb safety — allows the thumb safety to be "plugged" into the right or left side of the frame for right or left handers. Requires no special tools and can be done by the owner in about two minutes by field stripping.

Selective magazine catch — by merely turning a slotted screw head located in the right grip panel, allows the user to choose to have the magazine fall free from the gun, or to stop part way out and allow manual extraction.

Magazine cartridge indicator — indicates the number of cartridges in the magazine.

Two magazines come with each Bren Ten model.

All models have a Stainless Steel frame which provides corrosion resistance where needed, and at the same time ensures functional reliability and strength in the standard steel slide.

Recoil buffer — cushions recoil. When combined with backstrap design, offers greatest reduction in felt recoil attainable.

Dual screw driver set in pistol — designed to be an emergency field tool that fits all screws in the pistol.

Replaceable front sight — by field stripping, allows the front sight blade to be replaceable.

Replaceable screw-in bushing.

Bushing lock — ensures, no matter how loosely screwed in the bushing is, that it cannot come out. Guarantees functional reliability.

Three-dot sighting system — comes standard with the most visible and easily picked-up sights available. Consists of a single white dot on the black front sight blade, and two white dots on the black rear sight. When held in the shooting position, the three dots appear the same size, and are designed to be lined up in a horizontal plane at six o'clock on your target.

Positive grip grooves on front and back strap, and on front of trigger guard.

Military style trigger guard — allows for glove clearance.

Lanyard loop — modern design for those agencies or individuals that require it.

Designed inherent accuracy and natural pointability — because of the precision of the computer controlled machines that produce the Bren Ten, there is complete parts interchangeability and out-of-the-box accuracy that is an integral part of the pistol itself. The grip angle in relation to vertical, which is exactly 17 degrees, combined with the grip tang angle, which is exactly 12 degrees, plus the deep inset in the backstrap, all add up to a natural pointability that is second to none.

Large cartridge capacity — twelve in 10mm; ten in .45 ACP; thirteen in .22 L.R.

Factory standard combat features — includes trigger job, throated chamber, polished feed ramp, enlarged ejection port, beveled magazine well, and all corners and edges rounded for no-snag operation.

Made in U.S.A. — all parts and materials are 100 percent American made.

BREN TEN STANDARD MODEL



The Bren Ten Standard Model is a full-size, heavy-duty, semi-automatic, defensive combat service pistol designed to fire the 10mm Auto pistol cartridge. The Bren Ten was conceived by Jeff Cooper as the ultimate combat pistol and engineered and developed by Dornaus & Dixon Enterprises. It is the ultimate extension of the basic Browning design and is the natural evolution of the best and most proven pistols in the world, being much improved upon, along with revolutionary design features, an aesthetically pleasing appearance, and firing the optimum combat pistol cartridge. It is the basis for the entire line of Bren Ten 10mm Auto Combat Pistols.

BREN TEN POCKET MODEL

It is not a cut-down full-size Bren Ten, but rather a totally separate design that incorporates most of the features of the full-size model in the smallest practical size configuration possible, and at the same time fires full load 10mm Auto pistol cartridges. It is the world's most powerful production pocket pistol.

It has all of the custom features that Jeff Cooper has personally and expressly designated. This is a truly impressive pistol with such features as complete highly polished mirror-like finish on all surfaces, 22k gold plated detailing, custom laser engraved stocks, manufacturer's seal, registered serial number, Certificate of Authenticity, 12-22k gold plated 10mm cartridges, velvet lined wood presentation chest, custom laser engraved lid, and on the inside of the lid the owner's name inscribed on a plaque. This is the only production pistol ever to bear Jeff Cooper's name. It is a special one-time issue and will never be available again, with production strictly limited to 2000 pistols. This is the ultimate, absolute top-of-the-line, commemorative combat pistol.

.45 ACP Conversion Kit — Allows .45 ACP caliber ammunition to be shot from the Bren Ten. Consists of a .45 ACP barrel and fitted slide. Utilizes the same magazine for both .45 ACP and 10mm Auto cartridges. Cartridge Capacity: .45 ACP: 10 (10mm: 12). Fits all full-size Bren Tens.

.22 L.R. Conversion Kit — Allows .22 L.R. caliber ammunition to be shot from the Bren Ten. Consists of a .22 L.R. barrel, a fitted slide, a few small interior parts and a magazine. Cartridge Capacity: 13. Fits all full-size Bren Tens.

Competition Ambidextrous Thumb Safety — Designed for IPSC-type competition. Can be either factory installed or owner installed without tools. Functions like the standard thumb safety: i.e., thumb safety up — cocked and locked; thumb safety down — ready to fire. Fits all full-size Bren Tens.

Extra Magazines — Available for all models in either blued-steel or nickel-plated steel. Double column type for all full-size Bren Tens with a magazine capacity of 11 rounds for the 10mm, 9 rounds for the .45 ACP, and 12 rounds for the .22 L.R. Single column type for the Pocket Model Bren Ten with a magazine capacity of 7 rounds in 10mm only. The number of cartridges in the magazines can be determined by looking at the cartridge indicator on the side of the magazine.

10MM AUTO CARTRIDGE

Physically, the 10mm Auto cartridge is halfway between the 9mm parabellum and the .45 ACP round. It incorporates the desirable design characteristics of: Increased muzzle velocity (1100 to 1200 F.P.S.); high bullet weight (200 grains); and large cross sectional density (.400 inch). Ballistically, it is approximately comparable to the .41 Magnum, but, it feels like a .45 ACP when you shoot it. It is a very powerful and yet a very controllable round. It has between 538 to 640 foot pounds of kinetic energy at the muzzle. It has so much energy, that it retains more kinetic energy at 100 yards than a .45 ACP has at the muzzle. On the Hatcher Scale of Relative Stopping Power, its rating is 64 to 83, depending on the loading, which is higher than the .45 ACP round, and is much higher than the 9mm parabellum round. As a matter of fact, it rates superior to every single major production pistol cartridge on every measurable scale of performance. It is the optimum pistol cartridge. The 10mm Auto cartridge is being produced by Super Vel Cartridge Company, Fond du Lac, Wisconsin, and is an addition to their standard line. Super Vel is using a copper jacketed truncated cone shaped lead core bullet that is manufactured by Sierra Bullet Manufacturing Co., Santa Fe Springs, California.

The cartridge is a center fire, rimless, brass-cased, straight-walled design. It measures 1.25 inches in overall length, with the bullet measuring 10.16 millimeters (.40 inches) in diameter. It uses standard gun powder and a large pistol primer. Super Vel plans to introduce a second loading using a 185-grain, hollow-point bullet at an even greater velocity. The Super Vel 10mm Auto ammunition boxes feature the Bren Ten name as well as the Super Vel name, and is available wherever Super Vel ammunition is usually sold, or can be ordered directly from Dornaus & Dixon Enterprises, Inc.



TECHNICAL INFORMATION

All frames on all Bren Ten models are made from 17-4 precipitating hardening Stainless Steel. The finish, if light, is either polished or sandblasted Stainless Steel, depending on the model. If dark, the finish is black oxide, which looks and wears like high-quality bluing.

All slides on all Bren Ten models are made from 4130 alloy steel. The finish, if light, is high-density hard chrome. If dark, the finish is high-quality bluing.

The critical internal parts are made from hardened alloy tool steel. The barrels are made from chrome molybdenum steel.

Dornaus & Dixon Enterprises, Inc. will replace, without charge for parts and labor, any Bren Ten barrel that is shot-out (barrels normally worn out due to a large volume of firings) while the firearm is owned by the original purchaser. All that is required is that the barrel be properly maintained and cared for and that the firearm be returned to the factory for barrel installation. THIS WARRANTY EXCLUDES INCIDENTAL AND CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES.

ADDITIONAL LIMITED LIFETIME WARRANTY ON BREN TEN FIREARMS

Dornaus & Dixon Enterprises, Inc. warrants that it will repair or replace, without charge for parts or labor, any Bren Ten, or its component parts, found to be defective in workmanship or material for as long as the firearm is owned by the original purchaser. Dornaus & Dixon Enterprises, Inc. shall not be responsible under this warranty for any defect, failure, or malfunction caused by: abuse, misuse, unauthorized adjustments or modifications, or the use of reloaded or non-standard ammunition. 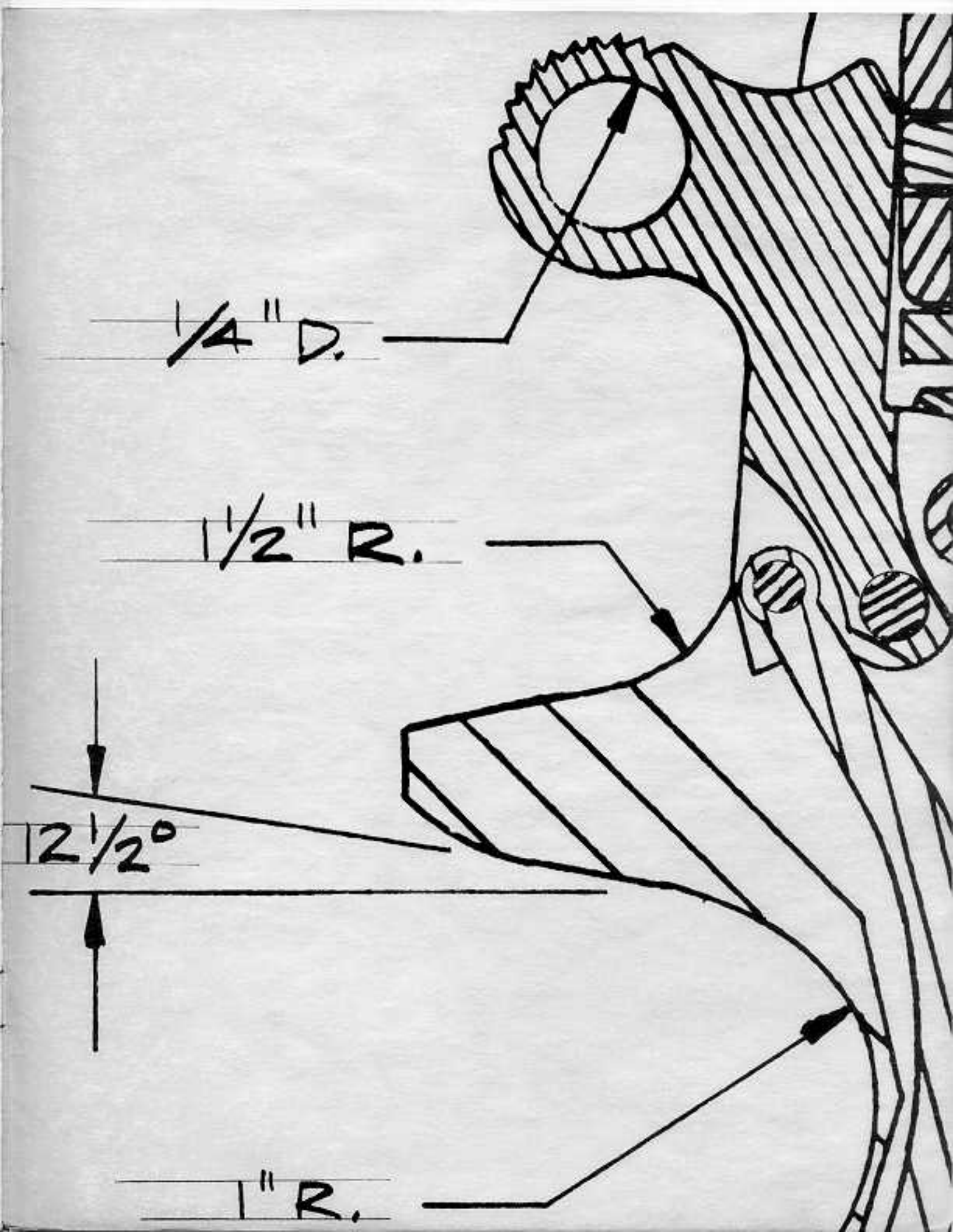

BREN TEN NAME ORIGIN

During World War II, the British produced the highly regarded ZB-26 light machine gun from their Enfield arms plant. Although produced in England, the design originated at the BRNO Czechoslovakian plant. Someone had taken the first two letters from the BRNO Czech plant and the first two letters from England's Enfield plant, resulting in the ZB-26 becoming informally known as the "Bren Gun." The Czech BRNO plant is still a source of finely designed weapons. The current Cz 75 is from the BRNO plant. The selective double/single action of the Bren Ten is based on the Cz 75 selective double/single action, although it has been strengthened and somewhat improved upon. Hence, Jeff Cooper recommended the name "Bren." The "Ten" designation is in reference to the 10mm caliber.

On July 15, 1981, Dornaus & Dixon Enterprises, Inc. became a legal entity and was incorporated by the Secretary of State, in the State of California. This many thousand square foot facility has within it some of the most modern state-of-the-art computer controlled equipment available today, which allows for precise workmanship second to none.
